
INVITATION

CONFERENCE VENUE

The Seventh International Conference on Fatigue of Composites will be held in the city of Vicenza. The venue selected is the Department of Management and Engineering at the University of Padova which is in the downtown, about 10 minutes walking from the Railway station. Vicenza is an extraordinary artistic masterpiece thanks to Palladio's buildings which are incorporated in a historical urban fabric and determine its whole aspect. For this reason, the city has greatly influenced European and world architecture and city planning rules. In 1995, with this motivation, the capital city of the Berici hills was listed in Unesco's World Heritage List. This prestigious award announced all over the world the beauty and the linearity of the shapes and colours which characterise the historic heart and the magical views of the city. Vicenza is still permeated by the spirit of Andrea Palladio, the architect who skillfully interpreted local noblemen's wishes.

CONFERENCE TOPICS

The main conference topics are:

- *Fatigue of composite materials*
- *Experimental characterization, damage mechanics and mechanisms*
- *Effects of defects, environment, variable amplitude, spectrum loading*
- *Health monitoring and NDT methods for damage detection*
- *Models and procedures for damage evolution assessment*
- *Residual properties and life prediction*
- *Applications and case histories: fatigue and property degradation in complex composite structures*

Together with these topics, suggestions for other topics as well as for special symposia are warmly welcome and can be forwarded to the Organising Committee.

YOUNG RESEARCHER AWARD

The Organizing Committee of ICFC7 decided to establish a Young Researcher Award to honor innovative research works in the field of composite fatigue. Winners will be announced and awarded with a signed certificate and a monetary prize during the conference dinner.

To be eligible, candidates have to:

- submit a single-authored paper
- attend the conference and present their own work
- be a young scholar under 32 years old.
