The Department of Engineering Science proposes to appoint a University Lecturer in Engineering Science in the general area of Solid Mechanics and Materials Engineering from 1st September 2012 or as soon as possible thereafter. The successful candidate will work at the Department of Engineering Science and will be offered a Non-Tutorial Fellowship at St Hugh's College under arrangements described in the further particulars. The salary will be on a scale currently from £42,883 per annum. The appointment will be initially for five years at which point, upon completion of a successful review, the post holder will be eligible for reappointment to the retiring age.

The successful candidate will have a strong background in Solid Mechanics and Materials Engineering or a cognate subject, including a doctorate or relevant experience. Candidates should have a proven research track record witnessed by peer reviewed publications and collaborations and relevant teaching experience. S/he will be expected to contribute to the teaching of her/his subject, which may include lectures and practical classes, and the supervision of undergraduate design and project work. He/she will also be expected to contribute to the current research in the Department of Engineering Science, obtaining external funding to enable development of independent research.

Applications are welcome in any area relevant to the research interests of the Solid Mechanics and Materials Engineering Group. We would particularly welcome applications from candidates with research interests in the area of composite materials.
