1. Develop Tenure System at NUS

- Instituted a US-Style tenure system with a rigorous appraisal system to set expectation for tenure and promotion.
- Tenure for faculty members was extended from 55 to 65 years old.
- A new remuneration system consisting of a basic component and other variable components reflecting differences in performance, responsibilities and market factors were introduced.

2. Create a culture that embraces excellence

- NUS was largely a teaching university for much of its history.
- When Shih took over as President in 2000, he outlined an ambitious goal of transforming NUS into a “global knowledge enterprise” by challenging NUS faculty members and students to compete with the best universities in the world.
- Actively recruited global talents and embrace them.

3. Found NUS Overseas Colleges (NOCs)

4. Develop Deep Partnerships With Leading Universities

- Under Shih's leadership, NUS teamed up with leading institutions worldwide to foster multi-disciplinary, multi-lateral collaborations.
- Shih led the Association of Pacific Rim Universities (APRU), comprising leading research universities in the Pacific Rim, including Stanford University, California Institute of Technology and Fudan University.
- Prof Shih was instrumental in the formation of the International Alliance of Research Universities (IARU), a group of 10 leading research universities that include Yale University, University of California, Berkeley, ETH Zurich, University of Tokyo and Peking University.
- NUS established a second medical school in partnership with Duke University, to pioneer US-style graduate medical education in Asia.

5. Build University Town

- Home to Singapore's first residential colleges.
- Home to CREATE (Campus for Research Excellence and Technological Enterprise), which houses research activities from 9 top universities.
- Excellent opportunities for interaction among diverse student and research communities
